1. Review Report on External Academic and Administrative Audit:

IQAC has ensured to achieve some of the short term goals and long term goals decided in the previous meeting. Following up action for the rest of the goals were in progress. [Annexure-1]

2. Result Analysis:

Associate Dean Finishing School prepared a schedule in consultation with the respective HODs and remedial classes were conducted for students those who are having backlogs. [Annexure-2]

3. NBA Accreditation:

NBA SAR for M.Tech (Power Electronics) was submitted on 21 May 2019 by EEE department and awaiting for the inspection dates. Preparations for NBA visit are completed.

4. Improvement of Publications:

- Associate Dean R & D has conducted 2 awareness programs about R&D opportunities for faculty.
- GRIET R&D wing organized a guest lecture and interactive session on 17/08/2019 on "Funding Opportunities in India, Research proposals writing and possible collaborations with IITM, IITB" by Dr. Prasada Raju, Phd, FNAE, MVGR College Of Engineering, Vizianagaram.

5. Continuous Monitoring System for different Entities:

For continuous monitoring system of different entities IQAC has prepared Google Forms and collecting data as per the frequency of reports. Purchased ECAP campus automation software was purchased.

6. New Initiatives by IQAC:

- Number of OUTREACH programs have been conducted by each department in the institution.
- As per guidelines given by Swachhta Pakhwada week GRIET is striving to reduce plastic usage.
- HOD's are requested to motivate faculty to use steel lunch box and steel water bottles instead of plastic.
- Major Plantation drives Harithaharam and 15 August 2019 were conducted by Green Campus team and planted large number of plant in and around the campus.
- NSS team organized an Outreach activity in the Govt. School in the village Lalsahebpet, Gajularamaram on 23/08/2019. The EEE students participated in the event and distributed books, stationary, refreshments to the school children also conducted games for school children.
- As a part of Outreach Program, IT Department distributed 17000 saplings across 17 schools in the city. The students were also educated on the importance of environment protection. Program was done in collaboration with INF-Insight the Needful Foundation NGO and the Telangana State Government Harithaharam Project.
