It was highlighted by the chair on the roles and responsibilities of various committees related to disciplinary matters that will be dealing with the following issues. The details are available on the institute website.

1 a). Ragging Issues: The UGC and JNUH instructions received as mandatory and those from time to time on ragging in Colleges. The anti-ragging measures to be implemented, various punishments attracted for different actions by students that are liable for punishment under the Anti-ragging act.

- b) Conflicts between students and with staff.
- c) Conflicts between freshers (1st B.Tech) and Seniors in particular
- d) Sexual harassment.

2. Modes of Representation for redressal:

The students were implored, never to take matters into their own hands but to make representations through various modes specially made available

- a) through e-mail.
- b) Handwritten complaints through proper channel.
- c) through suggestion boxes
- d) Oral complaints to mentor or Head of department.
- e) Entry in Grievance Redressal register available at reception.

3. Publicity: Spreading awareness vide:-


- a) Anti-ragging Posters

4. Avoidance measures adopted:

- Staggered class hours, lunch and Bus service timings
- Affidavit from students and their Parents

- Instructions to transport staff to deter mixing of junior and senior students and to report incidences and misbehavior.
