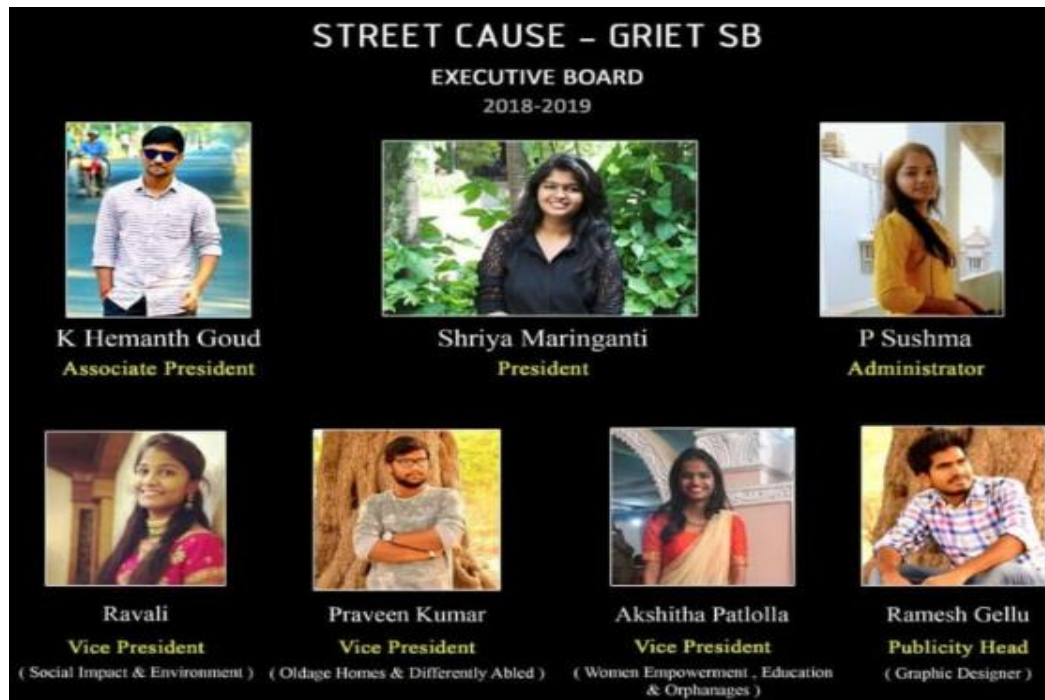

Task taken up by:Women Empowerment and Social Impact portfolio's.

Task Venue: Ettigadda Sangam ,Malapahad and Bobiligum.

Task details:

We, the members of Street Cause GRIET ; continued with our permanent event in Ettigadda Sangam . We organised a medical camp and distributed medicines for free. The medicines were sponsored by Sri Mahesh pharma through one of our team members. Resident's of the local 2-3 village's visited the medical camp.It was a two day event with doctors coming down from Balaji medicover hospital. A total of 5 doctors along with 3 nurses handled the check ups.The course of the event's over the two days period is mentioned as below:Day 1 : We personally visited each and every house of the village for promoting the camp , set up posters and banners at the camp point. We approached the village head to help us in the announcements. We almost reached around 500 people as a part of the promotions. Day 2 : Medical camp was set by 9:00 in the morning. The camp mainly focused on the eye check up for the aged .The camp also provided other doctors from various departments like Orthopaedic, Ophthalmology and general medication.We also had a ECG check up for the villagers along with BP level testing.The doctors were very cooperative and were kind enough to extend camp time till 2:00 pm to treat the patients.The overall medical camp was a reach out to 500 resident's and helped them meet their medical needs .

Location: Old Alwal, Hyderabad

Executive Summary: This report outlines the results of the event to be conducted at Good Samaritans. We had a strong purpose on choosing this old age home besides the rest as the condition of this old-age home is very threatening and dreadful. After letting their problems known to us, we have found that the elderly and the sick need a healthy environment and proper sanitation. Problems mentioned

- The home stinks a lot from the entrance itself.
- As the smell is unpleasant there are many insects.
- Near to the old-age home is an open place and has a pile of garbage which leads to arrival of mosquitoes and houseflies.

Considering the need of the elderly we did the following changes

1. Candle moulds: we will provide them with 3 different types of candle moulds along with raw materials like wax, threads. This would enable them to be selfemployed.
2. Sanitation: We will provide the home with sanitary products such as Dettol, Lizol. Also to help them get an ease from mosquitoes and houseflies we will give them giving mosquito nets. We are planning to distribute blankets and monkey caps as well.

Task Name : Renovation of washrooms and uplifting sanitation facilities in Hafeezpet Government Primary School.

Task number : 1

Task taken up by : SC GRIET (Women empowerment and Orphanage portfolio)

Task dates : 29/04/19 - 10/05/2019.

Summary:

The primary school comprising of nearly 259 students and 8 teachers was in dire need of proper sanitation and running water facility. Due to the constant problem of blockage of garbage and lack of water the current washrooms aren't in a state of usage. As a part of SC GRIET, we have provided them with the following:

1. Running water connection for 5 washrooms which were in complete bad condition
2. Tap connection for 2 washrooms (Faculty washrooms)
3. Placed an overhead tank of 1000 Lts capacity and ensured that required connections to kitchen, washrooms and wash bins are provided.
4. Provided 5 more taps for the students usage to wash their hands instead of going to the washrooms for washing their hands.

Budget break up:

1. Building material (trolley sand, stone and 2 bags of cement) : ₹5,000/-
2. Plumbing materials (1000 Lts tank, taps etc) : ₹8,000/-
3. Plumbing work: ₹7,000/-

4. Tapi Mason work : ₹4,000/-

5. Digging, lain work and drainage : ₹6,000/-

Total budget : ₹30,000/-
