	Faculty Qualification Upgradation	Under TEQIP-II, Institutions are expected to encourage faculty to upgrade their qualification from Bachelors to Masters and from Masters to Doctoral degree. If the facilities are available within the institution, the same need to be maximally utilized. Alternatively, the faculty could be deputed to other institutions for enhancement of qualification. Part-time or sandwich programmes can also be considered where feasible and necessary.
7.		In order to encourage more number of faculties for qualification up gradation under TEQIP-II programme, members as need to modify selection criteria as given bellow and to be made applicable from 2015-16 academic year starting on 1 July 2015:
		• All the Faculty members who are currently pursuing Ph.D. are eligible for financial support.
		• Maximum amount to be reimbursed for tuition fee is ₹ 20,000/- per year.
		• Maximum amount to be reimbursed for Fees charged for course work,
		Thesis writing, etc. is \gtrless 10,000/- during the entire course.
		• Expenditure for the publication of research work is one peer reviewed
		journal and to present a paper in one International Conference.
