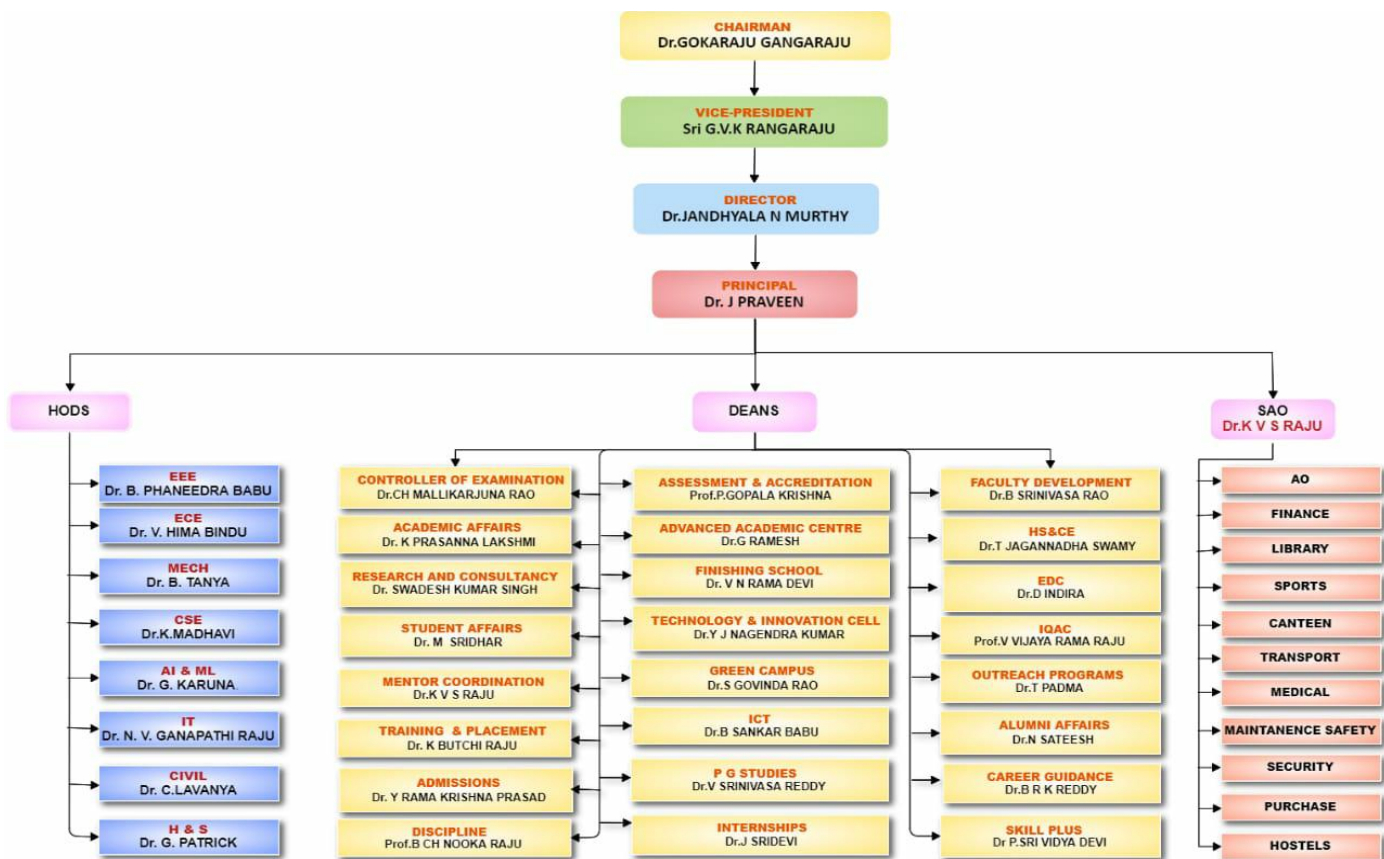

31. We closely work with TCS, Qualcomm, Cyient, CSC in skill Development for Faculty and students, Student Internships, Student Project Awards and Spoken Tutorial (ST), IIT Bombay, to offer the Spoken Tutorial based software training.
32. Our Entrepreneurship Development Cell is striving hard to imbibe the quality of Entrepreneurship and give support to interested students through training, practice, mentorship and networking. We are running an Entrepreneurship course for third year students and have generated 3 practice ventures through it. GRIET is a member of TEP initiative by ISB, through which our students are being imparted entrepreneurship seeding from second year of their studies. GRIET has started a course on Design Thinking for second year students to enhance their innovative and entrepreneurial abilities.
33. GRIET-EDC has been instrumental in promoting 12 startups. Students from CSE, ECE and IT have registered their startups under Udhog Aadhar Memorandum
34. **So far, our staff produced 2189 Papers (1669 in Scopus) plus 520 in other UGC and Crossref indexed journals & 24 books. From last three years 980 publications in Scopus with 1296 citations with a H-Index of 36.** During last 4 years and 6 patents granted, 49 published and 2 were filed. There are eight route buses for I, II and III years from LB Nagar, ECIL, Mehidipatnam, Uppal, Jeedimetla, SR Nagar, Kondapur and Lingampally. Teaching and other Staff are transported free of cost from Kukatpally, Miyapur and back.

(e) **Medical & First Aid Centre:** All medical needs are quickly and efficiently attended by well qualified Dr P Viswanath Raju along with a medical assistant Mr K Srinivasa Rao is available in college medical centre.

(f) **Water:** In spite of the hilly terrain and critical scenario in Hyderabad drinking and utility requirement of water was successfully met.

(g) **Power:** 413kWp Solar Powerplant which feeds the college power demand and rest is fed to National Grid through net metering. solar power plant annual average generation is 456043 units that is equivalent to planting 5303 natural tree's and reduction in 353 tone of co2 emission. Almost 80% load demand of collage is achieved by solar power only.

(h) Bank OBC branch along with ATM services s situated within college premises.

(i) **Stationery Store:** All types of stationery and photocopying needs of academic environment are met with by the store situated in Block I ground floor.
