6) Breach Of Agreement


8) Period of Validity







**Governing Law:** This Agreement will be governed by the laws of India and jurisdiction shall be exclusively vested in the courts at Hyderabad only.





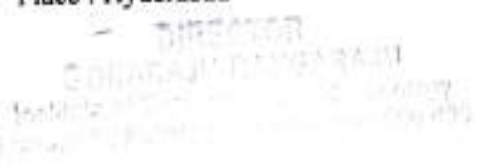

Wipro is seeking to collaborate with different universities and colleges to share the real time industrial knowledge and carry forward collaborative research projects in Electrical Vehicle Domain.

WHEREAS, GRIET is approved by AICTE, New Delhi, permanently affiliated to and autonomous under JNTUH. The Institute is one of the reputed and highest ranked (NAAC A<sup>++</sup>) private education institute in India. The Institute offers bachelors and master's degree programs in various Science and various other streams. The Institute is equipped with necessary infrastructure to carry out training, research, consulting, and other related services.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE COVENANTS AND MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH HEREIN, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Wipro and Institute will collaborate to explore academic, research programs and business opportunities for mutual benefit.
2. Wipro and Institute will identify potential opportunities for joint research programs, which may be executed and delivered by the parties together or independently.
3. Wipro may provide personnel to facilitate work from Institute facilities on projects identified for collaborative business and research programs, based on the terms and conditions as may be separately agreed upon for each of those identified projects.
4. Each party reserves and retains all right, title and interest in and to its proprietary software, products, and processes. Neither party shall take any action inconsistent with, nor that might adversely affect, other party's rights hereunder. Nothing contained in this MOU will be construed as granting or conferring any rights by license or otherwise, express or implied, or otherwise for any patents, copyrights, trademarks, know-how or other proprietary rights of either party acquired prior to or after the date of this MOU.
5. Each party shall treat the business, technical, financial information, negotiations and the content of this MOU as Confidential Information. Neither party shall disclose any confidential information to any third party without the consent of the other party or use such Confidential Information except to the extent necessary to carry out obligations for which it is been provided. This obligation does not apply if (a) it is or becomes generally available to the public; or (b) is independently developed by the other party without the use of such disclosed materials; or (c) has been acquired through a third party who is not obligated under this MOU; or (d) was already in its possession prior to the date hereof or (e) if the party is required to disclose by operation of law. The obligation shall survive three (3) years after the termination of this MOU. Parties acknowledge that the confidential information is valuable and unique. In case of breach, the affected party shall be entitled to



injunctive relief in addition to all other remedies available in law or equity including monetary damages.

6. Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations hereunder, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party or without its fault or negligence, including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, pandemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earthquakes, explosions, acts of god or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any governmental body.
7. During the term of this MOU, and for a period of one (1) year immediately following the termination of this MOU, neither Wipro nor Institute shall knowingly make an offer of employment to any officer, Institute or employee of the other who is involved with the efforts under this MOU, without prior written approval of the other party.
8. Institute agrees that Wipro has expended considerable time and resources in the exploration and determination of viable business opportunities with the Institute. As such Institute agrees that for the term of the MOU, Institute shall not actively invite a competing offer, or engage in competitive discussions with, any service provider other than Wipro. This period may be extended further by mutual agreement of the parties hereto. Provided, however, nothing in this clause 9 shall preclude Institute from entertaining a competing offer independently made by a third party without any solicitation or invitation from the Institute.
9. This MOU is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be only those expressly set forth herein.
10. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to grant either party the right to make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other without the other's prior written consent. At all times contemplated herein, Wipro and Institute shall remain independent contractors, each responsible for its own employees. Each party assumes no responsibility to the other for costs, expenses, risks, and liabilities arising from the efforts of the other.
11. Unless otherwise agreed upon by the Parties, the Sections 6 & 7 shall have binding effect and survive expiry / termination of this MOU.
12. Neither party shall assign, or in any manner, transfer its interest or any part thereof in this MOU, except to wholly-owned subsidiaries.
13. The parties may by mutual consent extend the term of the MOU, failing which this MOU stands terminated. Neither party is entitled to any compensation in the event of termination of this MOU. The terms and conditions of the proposed agreement shall prevail over this MOU.
14. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this MOU, any Exhibit or Attachment or any other document signed between the Parties regarding the subject matter of this MOU, either prior or subsequent to this MOU, under no circumstances will either party be liable for indirect, special, consequential or incidental losses or damages (including, but not limited to loss of profits, lost or damaged data, failure to achieve cost savings, loss of equipment or systems, or the failure of or increased expense of operations) of any kind, regardless of whether any such losses or damages are characterized as arising from breach of contract, warranty, tort, strict liability or otherwise, even if





such damages are foreseeable or either or both parties have been advised of the possibility of such damages. The maximum aggregate liability of parties under this agreement shall, regardless of the form of claim, be limited to USD 1000/- (one thousand US dollars only). Institute shall indemnify and hold harmless Wipro and its affiliates, officers, directors, and employees from any third party claims arising out of Wipro's usage of material provided by Institute. Likewise, Wipro shall indemnify and hold harmless Institute and its affiliates, officers, directors, and employees to the extent Wipro has proximately caused the infringement of any intellectual property rights of a third party except where said infringement is a result of Wipro's compliance with designs or specifications provided by Institute.

15. The parties recognize and understand that this document is an expression of intent and merely shall be considered as a starting point for further discussions and negotiations. Accordingly, except for relevant parts of Sections 5 – 18 nothing in this MOU shall be construed as to be legally binding for any of the parties and shall under no circumstances create any legal obligations or commitments. Hence and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this agreement, any Exhibit or Attachment or any other document signed between the parties regarding the subject matter of this agreement prior to this agreement, in no event shall either party be liable to the other for the non-fulfillment or non-performance by either party of its intentions laid down herein and neither party shall be liable to the other party for any loss of profits or revenue, or loss or inaccuracy of data or for any direct, indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages incurred by the other party as a result of such non-fulfillment or non-performance.
16. This MOU shall cease to exist after the expiry of three (3) years from the Effective Date ("Term"). Wipro and Institute agree to negotiate and draft a definitive agreement based on this MOU, as soon as practicable within the Term, and such supplemental agreements as are necessary to implement the foregoing, including license agreements, intellectual property agreements, non-disclosure and confidentiality agreements, and business operating agreements. The supplemental agreements will include performance and quality standards acceptable to each of the parties. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, either party may terminate this MOU by providing at least five (5) days' prior written notice in the event the other party has materially breached any of its obligations under Sections 5-18 herein and fails to rectify said breach within the notice period.
17. Neither Wipro nor Institute shall make any public announcement (including press release) regarding this MOU without consultation with and the prior written approval of the other party.
18. This MOU shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of India. Any and all disputes pertaining to this MOU shall be referred to Arbitration, the proceedings of which shall be governed by Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.






#### CO-OPERATION





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This memorandum of understanding entered into on **28 February 2021** between National Institute of Technology Warangal 506004, Telangana, an autonomous institute under Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India with its registered office at Warangal 506004, Telangana (hereafter referred to a NITW) of the first part

AND

Gokaraju Rangaraju Institute of Engineering and Technology(GRIET), Hyderabad Telangana 500090, was established in the year 1997 with the permission of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and the Government of Andhra Pradesh. GRIET is an autonomous Institute under UGC conferred in 2014 and recognized under Section 2(f) and Section 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956 (hereafter referred to as GRIET, Hyderabad) of the second part.

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

In order to facilitate collaborative research work, to establish academic and scientific relationships, to promote joint Research and Consultancy activities, to extend mutual support in Postgraduate and Doctoral programme, NITW and GRIET agree to establish this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

## 2.0 PREAMBLE

NITW has been recognized as Institute of National Importance by the Government of India. Formerly NITW was well known as Regional Engineering College (REC), Warangal first of its kind institutes established in 1959. In 2002, the College was renamed as National Institute of Technology Warangal and in 2007 it has been given the status of Institute of National Importance. NITW offers graduate, post graduate and doctoral programmes in different disciplines, contributing to the nation by developing qualified human resources.

Gokaraju Rangaraju Educational Society is a non-profit organization founded by a group of Industrialists with an idea of imparting purposeful education to youth. Gokaraju Rangaraju Institute of Engineering and Technology (GRIET), Hyderabad, Telangana



sponsored by the Gokaraju Rangaraju Educational Society, was established in the year 1997 with the permission of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and the Government of Telangana. The Institute offers 09 UG-B.Tech programmes and 06 PG-M.Tech Programmes.

### 3.0 THE SCOPE OF MOU

The scope of the collaboration in academic and research activities in this MOU include the following categories

- a) Academic and research collaborations in the mutually interested areas.
- b) Academic interactions and support leading to higher qualifications.
- c) Exchange of academic and scientific information.
- d) Joint Project proposals to be submitted to various funding agencies.
- e) Joint Publications in various Scopus/SC Indexed Journals.
- f) Use of Laboratory facilities at NIT Warangal for conduct of combined research.
- g) Sharing of Knowledge by organizing Workshops/ Seminars/ Faculty Development Programmes in advance technology areas.
- h) Allowing the faculty to do Ph.D programme on part-time basis/external mode/full-time basis at NITW.
- i) Students of GRIET to do summer internship with faculty at NITW and also Remote Internships and support for Technology Competition.
- j) Faculty Summer Research Fellowship – Faculty of GRIET to work with the faculty of NIT Warangal campus.
- k) To develop Joint Societal Impact Projects.

### 4.0 ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH COLLABORATIONS IN THE MUTUALLY INTERESTED AREAS

- a) Faculty from NITW and GRIET-Hyderabad can engage in collaborative research work, support and help each other in carrying research projects and Joint publications/ patents etc.



- b) Joint project proposals can be developed by the faculty members from NITW and GRIET - Hyderabad to submit to funding agencies such as DST, DBT, UGC, AICTE, NRB, DRDO, etc.
- c) Any intellectual property rights (IPR) in connection with the joint projects shall belong to both the institutions.
- d) The visible output in the form of conference proceedings, journal publications and book chapters which resulted from the collaborative research work, joint projects and research work that leads to Ph.D. degree, shall belong to the faculty members and credentials shall be given to them who involved and executed the work as per the research and publishing ethics.
- e) The research facilities at NITW can be utilized by the students and faculty of GRIET - Hyderabad as per institute norms with applicable fee. Similarly, the research facilities at GRIET campuses can be utilized by the students and faculty of NITW as per Institute norms.
- f) Faculty of NITW and GRIET Hyderabad to develop joint societal impact projects and collaborations with other external agencies/ R&D organizations/ Indian and overseas Educational Institutions.

## 5.0 ACADEMIC INTERACTIONS AND SUPPORT LEADING TO HIGHER QUALIFICATIONS

- a) As GRIET - Hyderabad is well established autonomous institute and majority of faculty members in GRIET - Hyderabad are postgraduates from premier institutes such as IITs, NITs and Central Universities, NITW shall give opportunity to faculty members of GRIET - Hyderabad to register for Ph.D. on part-time/external mode/ full-time subject to their meeting the admission criteria and based on interview performance.
- b) The faculty can complete the required courses by self-study and can appear for the examinations. GRIET - Hyderabad shall grant permission to the faculty members who register Ph.D at NITW to write those examinations.
- c) If a faculty member of GRIET - Hyderabad registers for Ph.D. degree at NITW, he shall have one guide at GRIET - Hyderabad and one guide at NITW.
- d) A faculty member at GRIET - Hyderabad act as internal guide.





- e) If guide is not available in the parent department from GRIET - Hyderabad or NITW in the proposed research area, eligible faculty who belongs to allied departments can act as one of the guides. However, in such cases, one guide must be from the parent department either at GRIET - Hyderabad or NITW.
- f) The remaining Ph.D. guidelines, rules and regulations as per the NITW shall be followed.
- g) The Instruments, equipment and other research facilities at NITW can be utilized by the faculty members for their Ph D. work as per institute norms.

## 6.0 EXCHANGE OF ACADEMIC AND SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION

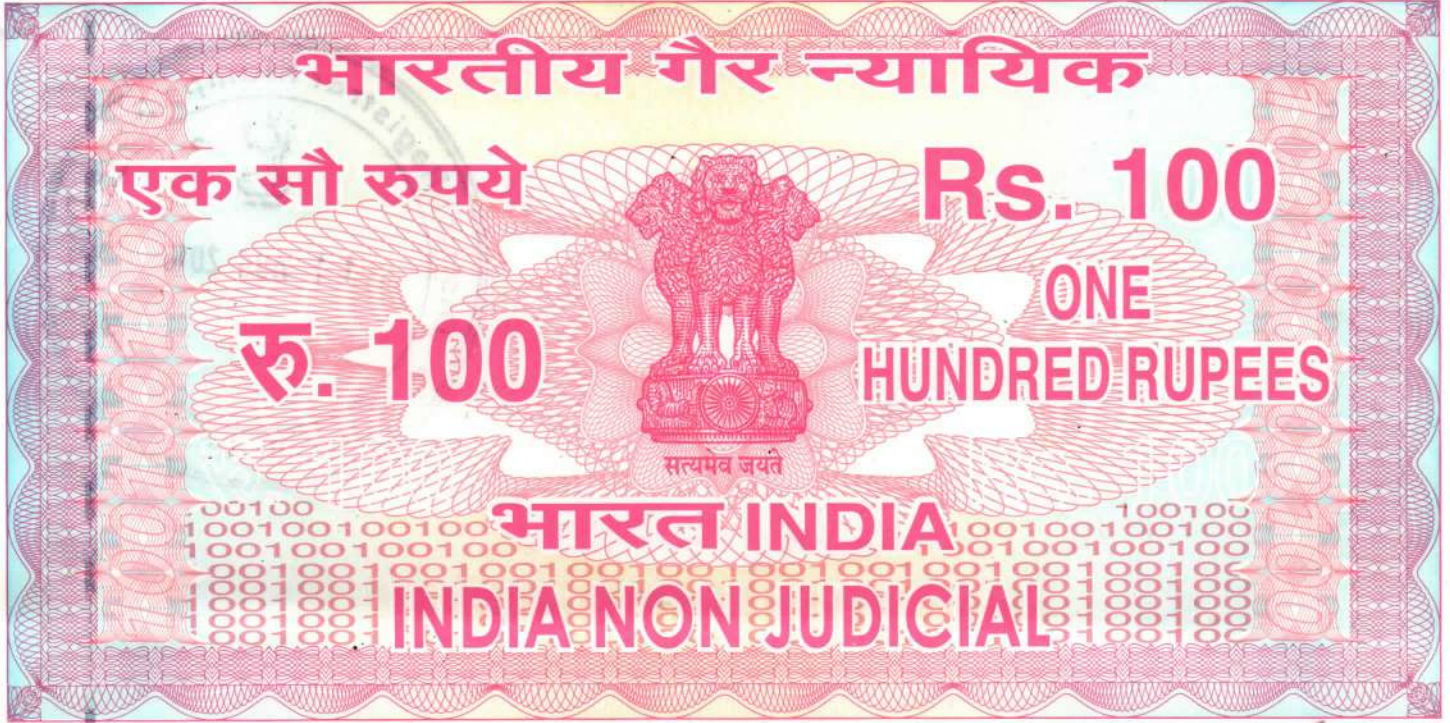




