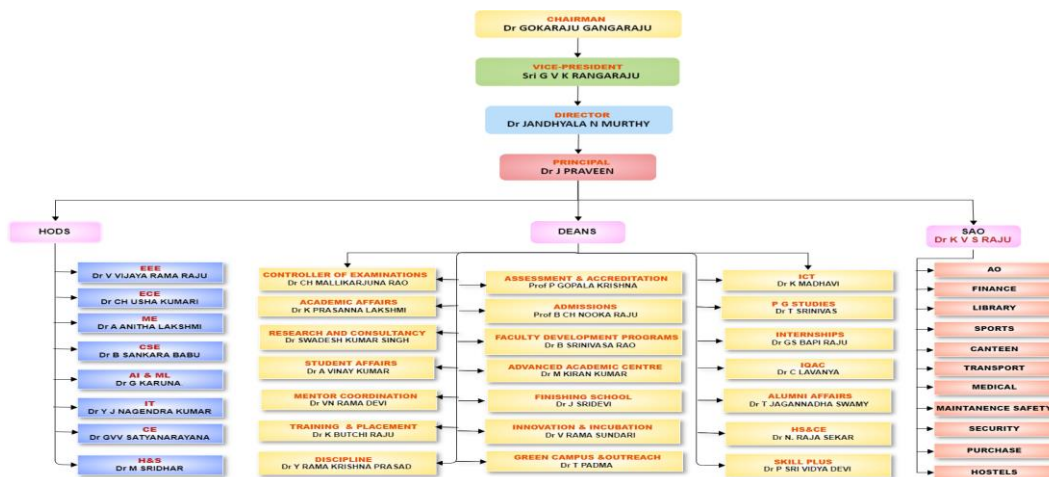

We are proud that 6 of our B Tech branches of EEE, ME, ECE, CSE, IT are accredited by the National Board of Accreditation, New Delhi in 2006, 2009, 2014, 2017, 2020 and 2024, B Tech (CE) in 2016, 2019 and 2022, M Tech (DFM) in 2016 and 2022, M Tech (PE) in 2016, 2018, 2020 and 2023, M Tech (CSE) in 2018 and 2020, M Tech (VLSI, Strcu Engg) are accredited by the National Board of Accreditation, New Delhi in 2018, 2020, 2023.

16. NAAC had inspected and granted us accreditation with A++ grade for a period of five years till 22 Feb 2026.

17. We have been granted Autonomous status by JNTU Hyderabad from 2011-12 by UGC from 2014 till 2030-31. Autonomous status gives us the academic freedom and vindicates our strengths to develop best practices and follow them with conviction. Our academic regulations called GR11 were implemented in 2011 and GR14 implemented in 2014-15, Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) was introduced from 2015-16 academic year with GR15 regulations. GR17 regulations implemented in AY 2017-18 gave us enough experience and confidence and to get ready for GR18 regulations introduced with effect from 2018-19 according to AICTE Model Curriculum. As par with the current industry demand and inputs from various stakeholders in AY 2020-21 GR20 regulations were introduced. GRIET introduced new regulations from AY 2022-23 called GR22 for both UG and PG based on NEP 2020. GR24 regulations implemented from A.Y 2024-25 has a provision for courses with internal evaluation.
18. We are proud that Gokaraju Rangaraju Educational Society (GRES) is recognized as Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (SIRO) by DSIR renewed for a period of three years till 31.03.2026.
19. These recognitions surely invigorate all of us to maintain quality standards in our learning environment. We are one of the few institutions who have a permanent affiliation status with JNTUH.

## Sports and Games

This academic year also witnessed an excellent performance by our students and staff in extracurricular segment as well. All the local competitions were keenly fought and participated with perfect spirit of sportsmanship. We have won quite a few tournaments held in and around Hyderabad in 2023-24.

## R & D and Consultancy

23. We have channelized our R&D and consultancy efforts through faculty as well as student members from each department. Currently we have FIST projects from DST worth 183.66 lacs, AICTE worth 55.83 lakhs and AR&DB 40.74 lakhs, UGC worth 9 lakhs and ongoing, so far received 1490.25 lakhs plus towards grants. Received Rs 24 lakhs from AICTE Margadharshan Scheme, Rs. 9.23 Lakhs under Prerana Scheme, Rs 16.66 Lakh exclusively for skill development of SC/ST Students from AICTE, 67.83 Lakh form MSME.

24. GRIET has been selected for the establishment of AICTE IDEALab. We are one of the few colleges in Hyderabad to get this prestigious selection. About Rs 40 lakhs has been spent in buying mandatory equipment such as electronic and mechanical design and fabrication tools such as PCB milling machine, laser engraver, Vinyl cutter, 3D printers, soldering stations, drilling machines, CNC router, lathes etc. The Lab will help students and faculty of all streams to convert their ideas into working prototypes. The Lab has started operating and has successfully completed skilling programs in different areas such as additive manufacturing, PCB design and mobile app development.
25. We have signed MOUs this year with IIT Hyderabad, Information Data Systems(IDS), IEEE Hyderabad section, SIDAK Defence & Aerospace Pvt. Limited, Delhi, Uttaranchal University, Cambridge University and Cambridge University in this academic year.
26. 868 papers published in International/National conferences and Journals. Our faculty participated in more than 600+ Workshops in 2023-24.
27. We are recognized as an Incubation Center by MSME in 2012 and 2020. We have received a funding of Rs 15 lacs for 1 Innovative project in 2023.
28. We closely work with TCS, CSC, Infosys Springboard, Spoken Tutorial (ST)-IIT Bombay, ICT academy, NPTEL and many more to enrich Skills for both Faculty and Students where students do internships, courses, Software training, Placements etc.
29. Our Entrepreneurship Development Cell is striving hard to imbibe the spirit of Entrepreneurship among our students who are interested in the field by conducting various activities like E-Talks, Business Idea Competition, E-Summit , Marketing Genix etc . Every year we spread this awareness to hundreds of students and thereby introduce them towards this career option
30. Our Institution Innovation Council (IIC) at GRIET is actively engaged in fostering innovation and entrepreneurship through various initiatives, including the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC), Advanced Academic Centre(AAC), IDEA Labs, Smart India Hackathon (SIH), Skill Development Courses, and other additional innovation and entrepreneurship-related courses. For the academic year 2023-24, our IIC has organized and submitted a total of 83 events. These include 30 IIC calendar activities, 6 MIC activities, 35 self-driven activities, and 12 celebration activities, all under the Innovation and Incubation component. Through IIC, we identify and support students with an interest in innovation and entrepreneurship by providing training, practice opportunities, mentorship, and networking. This year, GRIET introduced a Design

Thinking course for second-year students to further enhance their innovative and entrepreneurial skills. Additionally, IDEA Lab hosted workshops on PCB design, IoT, RoVe2 robot making, drone making, and 3D printing. Our IIC members actively participated in notable events such as the BVR SCIENT Inaugural event, TiE Grad Plus Launch event, IP Quality Labs at T-Hub, and MSME events. Under the EDC, five MSME projects were completed this academic year, with one project currently ongoing.

31. Furthermore, GRIET faculty have published 35 patents in 2024, with two patents granted and one patent with GRIET as the first author.

### **Student Association**

Our IEEE student branch, which is very active, has been conducting many events for the past 15 years. IEEE GRIET SB chapter is one of the largest SB chapters in Telangana region with active student members count of 300, professional members of 30 (including 12 senior members),



established new student branches – RAS, CAS, IAS, IES, CIS, TEMS, and Sensor council. IEEE GRIET PES SB Chapter received PES High Performing Student Branch Chapter Award and received grant of \$150 and IEEE GRIET IES student branch chapter received a grant of \$437 for organizing one week workshop on recent advancements in e-mobility. It brought laurels to the college by winning "IEEE Regional Exemplary Student Branch Award in 2020 and 2022 at Global IEEE. IEEE GRIET SB Triumphs with the IEEE India Council Outstanding Student Branch Award 2023. Darrel Chong Student Activity Gold Award for Pragnya'22.

Mr Anirudh Ambati received outstanding student volunteer award 2022 and selected as the Co-lead of the IEEE India Council Student Coordination Team 2023, representing the prestigious IEEE Hyderabad section. GRIET faculty members are actively involved in volunteering Hyderabad section, in different societies in different capacities as chair, vice chair, Secretary and treasurer. IEEE GRIET SB chapter actively involved in hosting 4<sup>th</sup> International conference on Sustainable energy and future electric transportation ( SeFeT 2024) financially co-sponsored by IEEE Industrial Applications society and IEEE Power Electronics society; technically co-sponsored by IEEE Power and Energy Society and IEEE Industrial Electronics Society. IEEE GRIET SB conducts several activities of national and international repute, on average every year it conducts 100 events.

## **Support Facilities**

32. The following facilities are available to ensure the environment is conducive to learn and develop.

(a) **Library:** Library, with over one lakh thirty thousand plus volumes with 17 thousand plus titles, adequate number of journals and e-resources caters to the needs of students and staff. The library is networked and automated purely by the efforts of our staff in terms of bar-coding and software. An act to show our self reliance.

(b) **Networking:** More than 2000 computers in college through LAN and fiber back bone with 1000 Mbps internet facilities, 5 servers, WiFi in selected corridors

(c) **Canteen:** Good canteen to provide meals, Breakfast, hot snacks are in position along with stalls to serve coffee and beverages and bakery items and fruit juices at reasonable rates. A free meal scheme namely Annapurna Nitya Prasadam Scheme was initiated by GRIET from the year 2012, to promote

concept of giving back to society amongst students. This scheme provides free lunch for faculty, staff and students. Presently this scheme is on hold after covid pandemic.

(d) **Transport:** The college is situated 4 kms from JNTUH, Kukatpally. Public Transport is conveniently available through TSRTC bus service up to Kukatpally, Hyderabad-metro and through MMTS up to Hi-tech City. Hence, we are running our own buses to transport the students from Kukatpally, MMTs (Hi-Tech City), Miyapur and back at a nominal charge. There are eight route buses for I, II and III years from LB Nagar, ECIL, Mehidipatnam, Uppal, Jeedimetla, SR Nagar, Kondapur and Lingampally. Teaching and other Staff are transported free of cost from Kukatpally, Miyapur and back.

(e) **Medical & First Aid Centre:** All medical needs are quickly and efficiently attended by well qualified Dr P Viswanath Raju along with a medical assistant Mr K Srinivasa Rao is available in college medical centre.

(f) **Water:** In spite of the hilly terrain and critical scenario in Hyderabad drinking and utility requirement of water was successfully met.

(g) **Power:** 413kWp Solar Powerplant which feeds the college power demand and rest is fed to National Grid though net metering. solar power plant annual average generation is 456043 units that is equivalent to planting 5303 natural tree's and reduction in 353 tone of CO<sub>2</sub> emission. Almost 80% load demand of collage is achieved by solar power only.

(h) Bank PNB branch along with ATM services s situated within college premises.

(i) **Stationery Store:** All types of stationery and photocopying needs of academic environment are met with by the store situated in Block I ground floor.

(j) **Pragnya Radio:**

Pragnya 90.4 FM radio licensed by Government, has been operating in GRIET, for the past 9 years and airing programmes for 5 hours daily. We also offer a certificate program in Radio Jockeying every year.
