

Summary of the Event	We met Devi Singh at his home in Dhoolpet. He told us about the critical conditions of the mini-stadium where he coaches for wrestling. All the students belong to very poor families who cannot afford any sort of coaching. At present, the academy has about 4050 students out of which 15 are young girls. 8 of these wrestlers have been to Nationallevel wrestling competitions and have won several medals. There is a lack in the number of wrestling mats and a cover making it difficult for all the students to practice simultaneously. We visited the wrestling academy and met the students. We observed all the students putting in great efforts into wrestling with immense concentration and dedication. The practice room does not have fans in working condition and lacks proper ventilation, making the practice area very claustrophobic. Girls and young boys practice on the mats without a mat cover which causes major injuries. Students cannot afford
	glucose which is an essential part of their practice and diet. They often injure themselves while practicing and do not have a provision of proper first-aid kit Budget Split per one kit:
