

Private Colleges of Telangana to Observe Engineer's Day as Black Day and Commence Indefinite Strike and Closure of All Institutions from 15th September 2025

In view of this grave situation, the FATHI Executive Committee presented its recommendations before the General Body today (14th September 2025). After deliberations, the General Body has resolved that **15th September 2025, Engineer's Day, will be observed as a Black Day across Telangana and that all private professional colleges will enter into indefinite strike and closure until the following demands are met by the State Government:**

1. Immediate release of the already budget-allotted amount of ₹1,200 crore before Dussehra.
 2. Release of all pending dues from previous years before 31st December 2025
 3. Release of the feasibility report on the Trust Bank proposal by 31st October 2025.
 4. Issuance of a GO on the new reimbursement system applicable from 2025-26 by 31st December 2025.
 5. Release of all fee reimbursement dues for the academic year 2025-26 before 31st March 2026.
 6. Admission policy, Fee reimbursement & fee fixation together to dealt by Govt.
- The managements deeply regret the inconvenience caused to students and parents, but emphasize that the responsibility for this unprecedented crisis rests entirely with the Government of Telangana.
