Let this year be the one in which you shine brighter than ever before and enter the new decade with a hardened resolve.



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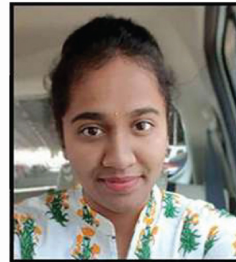
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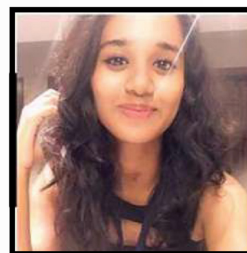
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Internal Hackathon SIH 2020

Smart India Hackathon 2020 is a nationwide initiative to provide students a platform to solve some of the pressing problems we face in our daily lives, and thus inculcate a culture of product innovation and a mindset of problem-solving.

The main motive of S.I.H is to Harness the creativity & expertise of students, Spark institute-level hackathons, Build funnel for 'Startup India' campaign, Crowdsolve solutions for improving governance and quality of life and provide an opportunity for citizens to provide innovative solutions to India's daunting problems.

In an event of such a scale that happens to be a National event, colleges for applying for the competition tend to conduct internal hackathons where they call student groups to come and present their solutions to them and the best among them are filtered, selected and then geared up for the main event.

This year CSI had the great opportunity to associate with the college to conduct the internal hackathon for SIH2020.

The event was held on the 29th of Jan 2020, where around 20 teams got registered for the event out of which 2 hardware solutions and 5 software solutions were selected.

The event being diverse as is, invited teams from all backgrounds. May it be from 4th, 3rd years, 2nd or even 1st years; it doesn't matter. Said that the event received great participation and some really good projects, which were graced by the knowledge and presence of industry experts and who guided students in the process.



The event began with an inaugural of guests, post which the G Mallikarjun Rao, the Spok for the event spoke about it in its nitty-gritty and later the HoD came and gave all teams a vote of confidence.

The event was to be of 3 rounds, but due to minor setbacks, it was changed to 2 rounds.



Round 1:

At the start they were asked to submit a presentation on their projects. Which was followed by visits of inn-college domain experts along with industry officials as mentioned earlier and they asked about the skeleton details of the project,i.e; software used and how and why they chose this, etc.

Round 2:

This round was defined by the industry experts coming and giving suggestions and feedbacks where they felt the project might fail and why.

The event was concluded once the teams had submitted their projects by giving one-one interaction with all the judges.

The next day the team results were announced and the event concluded.

is this door.

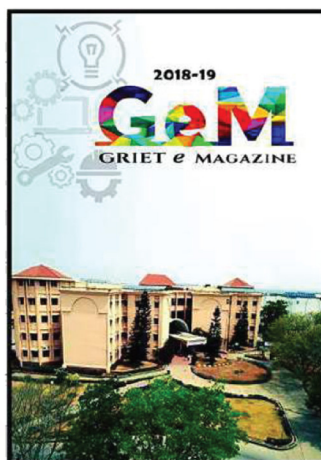
Having many a key,

go wrong,

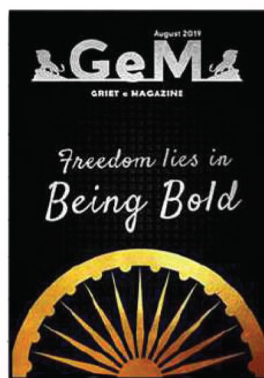

all of "The All-Mighty" with glee.



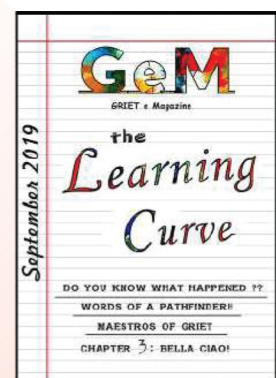
