ONLINE CLASS WORK

- (1) classes for all B.Tech and M.Tech students are being conducted ONLINE using Newton Classroom Software since 30 Mar. 2020.
- (2) The faculty can record their class and post it in the Platform itself. Students who are having connectivity problems can download these recorded classes at their convenience and then view it.
- (3) Principal & HODs login and see how the faculty are delivering their sessions.
- (4) Due to constant interaction with students and parents, the attendance of students for online classes has crossed 80%.
- (5) Deployment of this Platform has greatly eased out most of the problems associated with online teaching.
- (6) All other activities like FDPs/Conferences are also conducted through online mode only.
- (7) Facility for exams and quizzes is being developed.

(8) Two FDPs are Conducted with Resource persons from premier institutions of India, abroad and GRIET for all faculty on improving online teaching effectiveness
