

## CHEYUTHA- G assist

### 1. Foreword

Higher education with engineering as one of its component is vital to the economic status of any country. Engineering profession endeavours to improve quality of life, betterment of Society sustaining environment. This education needs to be of quality for maximizing results. It is known that quality education costs and may not be affordable by all, especially by those from economically weaker sections. They deserve assistance and a positive action is needed from our institute. This is in tune with our strategic goals 2015-20, providing equitable and affordable education.

### 2. Aim

GRIET shall provide scholarships to those who are not covered by government or nongovernmental scholarships towards tuition fees and other support services. And the scheme shall be known as CHEYUTHA- G assist.

### 3. Objective

To offset the economic disadvantage of eligible undergraduate students suitable scholarship under "Cheyutha-G assist" scheme shall be given in each academic year towards full/partial amount for

- (a) Yearly Tuition Fees
- (b) Yearly Examination Fees
- (c) Yearly Bus Fees
- (d) Yearly Canteen Tokens

### 4. Amount

GRIET shall support the scheme with Rs 55 lakhs per annum and shall increase it by five lakhs every academic year.

### 5. Beneficiaries:

The scheme endeavours to benefit as many students by appropriately limiting the maximum amount under various categories in para 3 above. Each department should benefit by at least three students for every sixty in each year of programme.

### 6. Eligibility

The following conditions have to be satisfied for a student to be eligible for the award.

- (a) Student should not be in receipt of any other governmental or nongovernmental scholarship.
- (b) Parents income should be less than 8 Lakhs for annum.
- (c) Counselling/Spot candidates are only eligible.
- (d) For second to fourth years, student should have no backlogs in the previous year and average attendance should be 80% or more. Students CGPA/ intermediate marks shall be considered for the award.
- (e) Children of Defence personnel serving or retired, or girl student will be given preference if all other conditions are same.

7. Scholarships to be announced by first week of respective academic years. Decision of Management shall be final.
