3	To review Audit Inspection Observations	TEQIP Coordinator briefed the observations of the audit 05-06 Feb 14:
		1. Members have again endorsed payment of Rs 4000/- as honorarium to for the previous IIIC sessions for which audit was

		insisting it should not exceed Rs 3000/.
		2. Chairman directed coordinator to be more vigilant in future in completing all financial documents in all respects as the documents are liable to be scrutinized by external agencies.
		3. Members approved the payment of transport allowance to be booked under the IOC-Operations and Maintenance henceforth.
		4. Recovery of service tax already paid to three agencies including ASCI,Hyderabad, which is not required to be paid as per directive 09/2013 as objected by the audit, may not be possible, members recommended the TEQIP team to be cautious in future transactions and regularize this as expenditure under corresponding heads.
